


A Sing-Along Celebration of the Creed

A young woman, Mary, was chosen by God from all women to be the mother of God's Son, Jesus. When the angel Gabriel appeared to Mary and asked her to be the mother of God's Son, she immediately answered, "May it be done to me according to you Word," without hesitation (Luke 1:38). Her faithfulness and trust in God and his plan were immediate. She joyfully proclaimed that she was the servant of the Lord who was fully accepting of God's will.
