Read Genesis 1:26-31

Thursday

Read Zechariah 9:16

Friday

Read Matthew 18:1-5

Saturday

Read Matthew 19:13-14

Read Exodus 34:27-28

Tuesday

Read Mark 12:28-34

Wednesday

Read Luke 4:14-20

"What kind of king has come?" you ask.

He comes to raise the meek and small.
He comes, just as God said he would,
to save as only Jesus could.





















8. Kingly Blessings

Thursday

Read Matthew 5:1-5

When Jesus spoke, the people came to listen close to his good news. He taught them of the blessings which the Lord bestows on me and you. "God bless the meek and sad and poor. They have a heavenly home in store."

9. More Kingly Blessings

Friday

Read Matthew 5:6-9

God's blessings are like precious gems. He showers them from up above. God fills the hungry in their need. God loves all those who share their love. And to the peaceful and the pure— God's kingdom is for them, for sure.

10. Even More Kingly Blessings

Saturday

Read Matthew 5:10-12

Some people may say hurtful things to tease and taunt and bring you down. They say you shouldn't love the King. They do not want to wear the crown. Keep serving God, and you will be blessed in his home eternally.












41. Our Risen King
