Teaching Plan

Teaching Tips

Ahead of introducing *Learning about the Sacraments* to the children, take time to familiarize yourself with the contents. Review this handout and how it correlates to the children's resource.

The resource is designed for children to interact with. Have the children follow along as you read aloud, and engage them in hands-on interaction with the resource, as suggested in the teaching steps below.

Background

Instituted by Christ more than 2,000 years ago, the Seven Sacraments of the Catholic Church are not simply rituals and traditions. They are real and powerful ways we connect with Jesus, his divine life, and the infinite and unconditional love of the Father. Through Christ's action and the Holy Spirit's power, God's grace is made present to us in tangible signs—words, actions, and objects—at each sacramental celebration of Baptism, Confirmation, Eucharist, Reconciliation (confession), Anointing of the Sick, Matrimony, and Holy Orders.

Keep this definition in mind as you teach: A Sacrament is an outward sign instituted by Christ to give grace. Help the children look for these outward signs (water, bread, wine, the laying on of hands, etc.). Guide them to discover the Gospel accounts of Jesus giving us the Sacraments. Most importantly, encourage the children to participate regularly in the Sacraments so they can experience God's living, loving, healing grace at work within them.

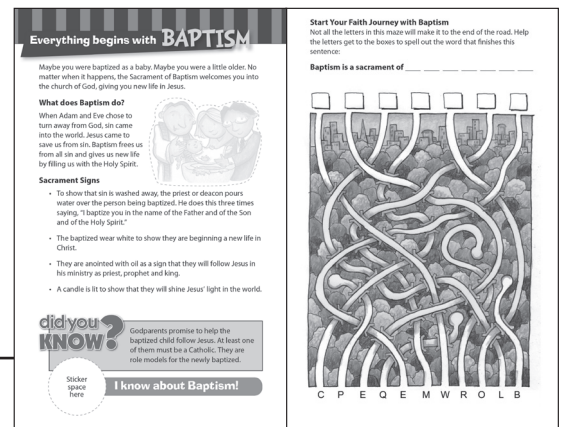
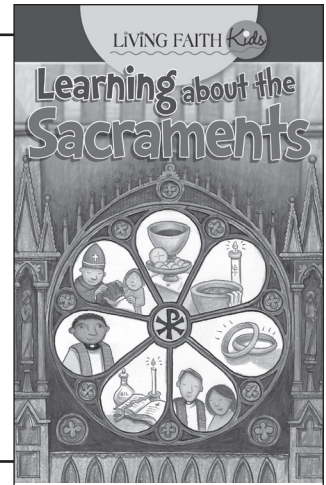
Opening Prayer

Begin your lessons with prayer. Use the following or modify it each time you pray it with the group.

Good Jesus, you have given us the Sacraments because you love us so much and want us to grow closer to you. Open our hearts and make us ready to receive you in the Sacraments so that you can come to live within us. Amen.

Teaching Steps

Page(s)	
COVER	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Direct the children to look at the cover of their booklets. Say, <i>We will be learning about the Sacraments, and how Jesus himself comes to live in us through them.</i> • Discuss the art. Ask if they can identify what is happening in the pictures, or what the objects represent. (For example, the two rings represent Matrimony.) Note the symbol in the center. Explain that these are the Greek letters "Chi" and "Rho," and that together, they signify Christ, who has given us the Sacraments. Ask, <i>What does the art all around it remind you of?</i> (Church. You might note that Jesus has entrusted the Sacraments to the Church.)
2-3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Read aloud the head and first paragraph. Ask, <i>What does it mean to welcome someone?</i> • Read the second paragraph. Ask the children how much they remember about the story of Adam and Eve and review it briefly together. If you have access to a Bible, read one of the Gospel accounts of Jesus' baptism, such as Mark 1:4-11. Reflect together on this quote: "I have baptized you with water; he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit" (Mark 1:4).



- **Read about Sacrament Signs.** Ask, *What are the signs at the celebration of Baptism?* (Water, white garment, oil, candle.) Ask, *Why do you think the priest says, "In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit"?*
- **Read "Did You Know?"** Ask the children if they know who their godparents are. If they don't know, invite them to find out. Ask, *If you were to choose someone to be a godparent, what kinds of qualities would you look for?*
- **Complete the activity.** If needed, help the children complete the activity on page 3.

For each Sacrament page pair (Reconciliation, Eucharist, Confirmation, Matrimony, Holy Orders, and Anointing), follow these steps:

- **Read aloud the text and "Did You Know?" facts as children follow along in their booklets.** Pause after key terms or phrases about sacramental signs and what the Sacraments do for us. Repeat them, and ask the children to underline them in their booklets. Have the children underline no more than five terms or phrases per page.
- **Discuss.** Ask questions that connect the Sacraments to Jesus and to children's experience. For example, *What does Jesus do for us in Holy Communion?* (Jesus gives himself completely—Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity. The Eucharist gives us strength to live as his followers.) *Have you ever been to a Mass where Baptism, Confirmation, or Matrimony was celebrated? What do you remember about it?*
- **Connect.** On each page, invite the children to place a check mark next to any of the sacrament signs they have seen, heard, or spoken (act of contrition, altar, chalice, sacred oil, wedding ring, etc.). Emphasize that these are the signs God himself gives us so that we can know he is present in a special way when we participate in the Sacraments.
- **Ask** if children know when and where they can receive Reconciliation and Eucharist. Point out Mass times and Reconciliation hours in your parish bulletin or website.
- **Look deeper.** (Optional) If you have access to Bibles, invite the children to read about the scriptural roots of the Sacraments: Eucharist: Matthew 26:26-29; Confirmation: Acts 2:1-4; Reconciliation: John 20:21-23; Anointing of the Sick: James 5:14; Matrimony: Genesis 2:24; Holy Orders: Matthew 10:1-8, Acts 6:3-6.

RECONCILIATION
A Gift of Great Love

When we sin, we hurt God and ourselves. Sin is like a stain on our hearts. It keeps us from seeing God clearly. But God loves us. He wants us to be close to him. He's given us the gift of the Sacrament of Reconciliation—also called Confession—so we can say we're sorry and be healed.

What does Reconciliation do?
When we sin, we separate ourselves from God. In Confession, we say what we have done wrong and that we are sorry. Through the power of the Holy Spirit, we are freed from our sins through the priest. Our sins are forgiven. We receive the gift of God's forgiveness. Because it brings us closer to Jesus, who loves us so much!

What is the "Seal of Confession?"
The "Seal of Confession" means a priest can never talk about anything he hears in Confession.

Sacrament Signs
Here's what happens in Confession:
1. **Examination of conscience:** Before Confession, we ask ourselves if our words and actions always show us love for God and others.
2. **Contrition:** We're sorry for the sins we haven't shown love.
3. **Confession:** We tell Jesus our sins through the priest.
4. **Penance:** We show we are sorry for our sins with prayers or actions.
5. **Absolution:** The priest forgives our sins in Jesus' name. Our sins are gone forever.

WE RECEIVE JESUS IN THE HOLY EUCHARIST

Imagine you're at the Last Supper. Jesus has washed, washed to and given to you. Now realize that you don't have to pretend. Every time we gather at Mass, Jesus is with us. When the priest says the blessing, he gives the power of the Holy Spirit to the bread and wine because Jesus truly and really is here. We receive this great gift in Holy Communion, just as the Apostles did at the Last Supper.

What does Holy Communion do?
When we take the bread and wine during Mass, we receive Jesus' Body and Blood. It gives us strength to live as his followers. If anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever! Jesus gives us himself completely—Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity—in the sacrament. As Baptism gives us new life in Jesus, the Eucharist is the special food that gives us strength to live as his followers.

Sacrament Signs
Here are some things you see and do at Mass when we celebrate the Eucharist:
• The altar, where bread and wine become Jesus' Body and Blood
• Gifts of bread and wine
• Water poured over the priest's hands
• The Host is the eucharistic bread
• The chalice holds the wine that will become Jesus' Blood
• Candles are glass holders for water and wine
• The paten is a plate that holds the Host
• Jesus is called the eucharist in a special way in the blessed hosts
• We share a blessing with those around us in the Sign of Peace
• Jesus means, "Bread!" We say "Amen" when we receive Jesus' Body and Blood

Hidden Mysteries
We can't see Jesus in the Eucharist, but we know and believe that he is present. Sacrament signs are things we can see that help us believe. Can you find them here (across, up and down, diagonally and backward)?

CONFIRMATION
The Seal of the Holy Spirit

After Jesus came from the dead and before he went to heaven, he promised us to send the Holy Spirit to us. At Pentecost, the Holy Spirit came in the form of tongues of fire. Jesus had promised. They realized through the power of the Holy Spirit that they were not alone. They received the power to baptize and heal people in Jesus' name.

What does Confirmation do?
When we're confirmed, we are sealed with the Holy Spirit that we received at Baptism. This special seal, or mark, of the Spirit is not a mark you can see like a dot or a circle, but it gives us strength to live following Jesus.

Sacrament Signs
Some ways you can tell the Spirit is present at Confirmation:
• A candidate is someone preparing to be confirmed.
• There's a direct line from Jesus' Apostles to the bishop, who leads the celebration.
• A candidate promises to lead holy lives and turn away from sin as they receive the Holy Spirit.
• In the laying on of hands, the bishop either extends his hands over the candidates or touches candidates on the forehead or forehead as a sign for the Holy Spirit's gifts.
• Candidates are anointed with sacred oil, called chrism. This shows they are sealed by the Holy Spirit.

In His Hands
In the Sacrament of Confirmation, the bishop places his hands over the candidate or may even place his hands over the candidate, just as Jesus did. That's powerful! Draw a line to match the Scripture quote to the picture it describes.

In Confirmation, you can choose the name of a saint as a sign that you want to live like the saint. See how?

- **Help.** Offer assistance if needed with the activities and affirm completion.
- **Extend understanding** by helping children see how the Sacraments are grouped together. Explain that the **Sacraments of Christian Initiation** are what make us part of God's family and strengthen us as the Body of Christ. They are Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist. The **Sacraments of Healing** are God's ways of making us well when we need spiritual or physical healing. They are Reconciliation and Anointing of the Sick. The third group of Sacraments are **Sacraments at the Service of Communion** and include Matrimony and Holy Orders. These give us God's grace to serve others in Jesus' name.
- **Assess Understanding.** Before children place each sacrament sticker, have them write or tell you two things they can remember about the Sacrament.

ANALYZING

Like Jesus, we care for the sick

When Jesus said, "Let us go, and you visited the lepers" (Lk 9:12), he was expressing a desire to help people who were sick. Catholics take Jesus' words very seriously. We care for the physically, emotionally, spiritually, and financially sick. We care for the sick of every age and of every race. People like St. Teresa of Calcutta care for the sick of every age.


